Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 - Section 135

TO BOOSTER WINE GROUP LIMITED PARTNERSHIP

The off-licence in respect of the premises situated at 243 Old Coach Road, Mahana and known as "Gravity Cellars Mahana" is renewed. Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, BOOSTER WINE GROUP LIMITED PARTNERSHIP is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act. The present conditions of the licence continue to apply. These are as follows:

CONDITIONS

- 1. HOURS: Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
 - (a) Monday to Sunday 10.00am to 9.00pm
 - (b) No alcohol is to be sold on or delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
 - (d) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made—
 - (i) on the premises; or
 - (ii) from grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated

2. RESTRICTIONS:

The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed.

- 3. WATER: While alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, free drinking water must be provided for customers at the tasting location.
- 4. DESIGNATED AREAS: The following part of the premises is designated as a: Supervised Area: Cellar Door Sales Area
 The defined area is the area outlined on the plan received 14 March 2024.
- 5. SIGNAGE: Signage must be displayed at each point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence expires on
